



Are you serving a cross racial and cross cultural (CRCC) appointment?
Have you been searching for practical and insightful resources to help you be effective in your CRCC ministry?

Then look no further! CRCC Madang has been designed to support you by offering learning opportunities and creating a community of KA CRCC pastors through networking to meet the needs and demands of CRCC ministry. CRCC Madang is a four-month program that begins with a week-long retreat followed by series of online courses.

ELIGIBILITY: Must be serving in CRCC appointment/ministry and have been in CRCC Appointment less than 8 years.

CLASS SIZE: 15 participants for the class of 2024 CRCC Madang & 20 participants for Madang Reunion. Admission is granted on a first come, first served bases.

WHEN: CRCC Madang begins with a retreat August 12-16, 2024, and followed by series of webinars from September 2024 to January 2025 (bi-weekly).
